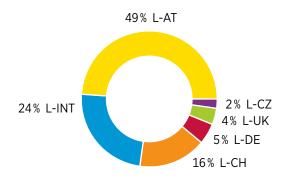
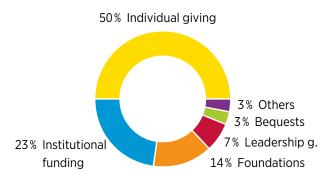

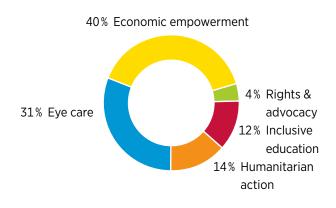

## RELIABILITY

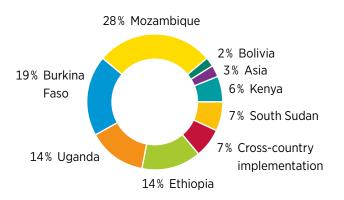

The income-expense gap on group level is attributed to the implementation of deferred income from previous years, as well as strategic investments aimed at further developing the organization for sustainable impact.

Through our 'ONE organization' approach we multiply the impact of funds we receive through our different entities and donors, and reduce the expense and overhead ratios through the realization of synergetic effects. This enables us to efficiently and effectively allocate our resources, aiming to invest > 70% of our total revenue into direct programmes implementation (percentages might slightly vary depending on level of investments into organizational development).
